### Three-Day Festival Features 14 Top Artists - Tickets Go On Sale Dec. 6

In 2015, Country Summer anticipates attracting more than 33,000 fans with more video walls and an enhanced staging and sound. Between main acts on the Montgomery Village Stage, there will be a secondary stage featuring local musicians and groups.
